The **Address** form administers additional addresses from Contact. The additional addresses are classified with help of type of address.

The form consists of the following elements:

- **Address:** This element designates distinctly the address in System.
- **Customer:** This field assigns the associated contact to the address.
- **Street:** The street is entered in this field.
- **Address Postal Code/City:** The postal code and the city for the address is entered in this field.
- **Country:** This field specifies the country.
- **Address code:** This field specifies the house post code of the address; e.g. for industrial parks and technology centers.
- **Address type:** This element is used to classify the address and consists of the characteristics visitor's address, commercial invoice address, delivery address and postal address.
