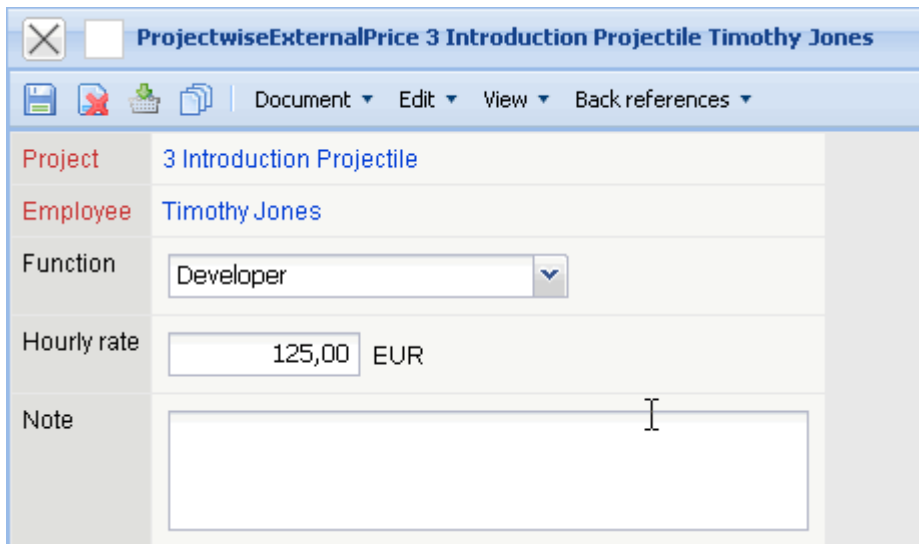


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2.02.10 Project-related Employee Rates

The **Project-Related Employee Rates** form administers the occupation rates, which are adjusted for a defined project. When these rates are defined for a project or sub-project, these values override the global employee rates (see also costing and pricing).
