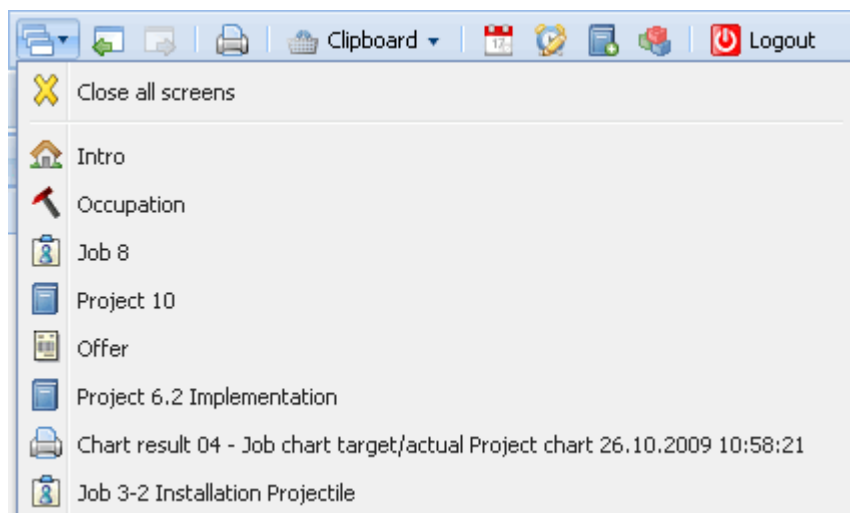


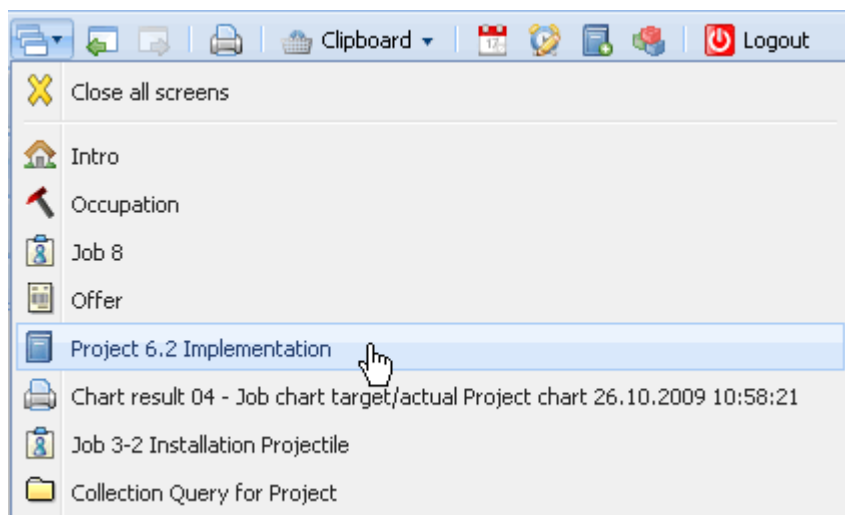
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3.02.2 Window Manager

A list of all open screens are in the lower part of the work area - the window manager. The listed screens can be opened directly or through this list. In the example, work area (Intro), are listed in the window manager.



One item in the list consists of the close button  for all opened screens and the items for opened screens with a link to the form. Changing to a form in the list, an item link is used ...

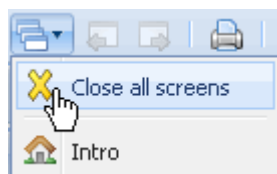

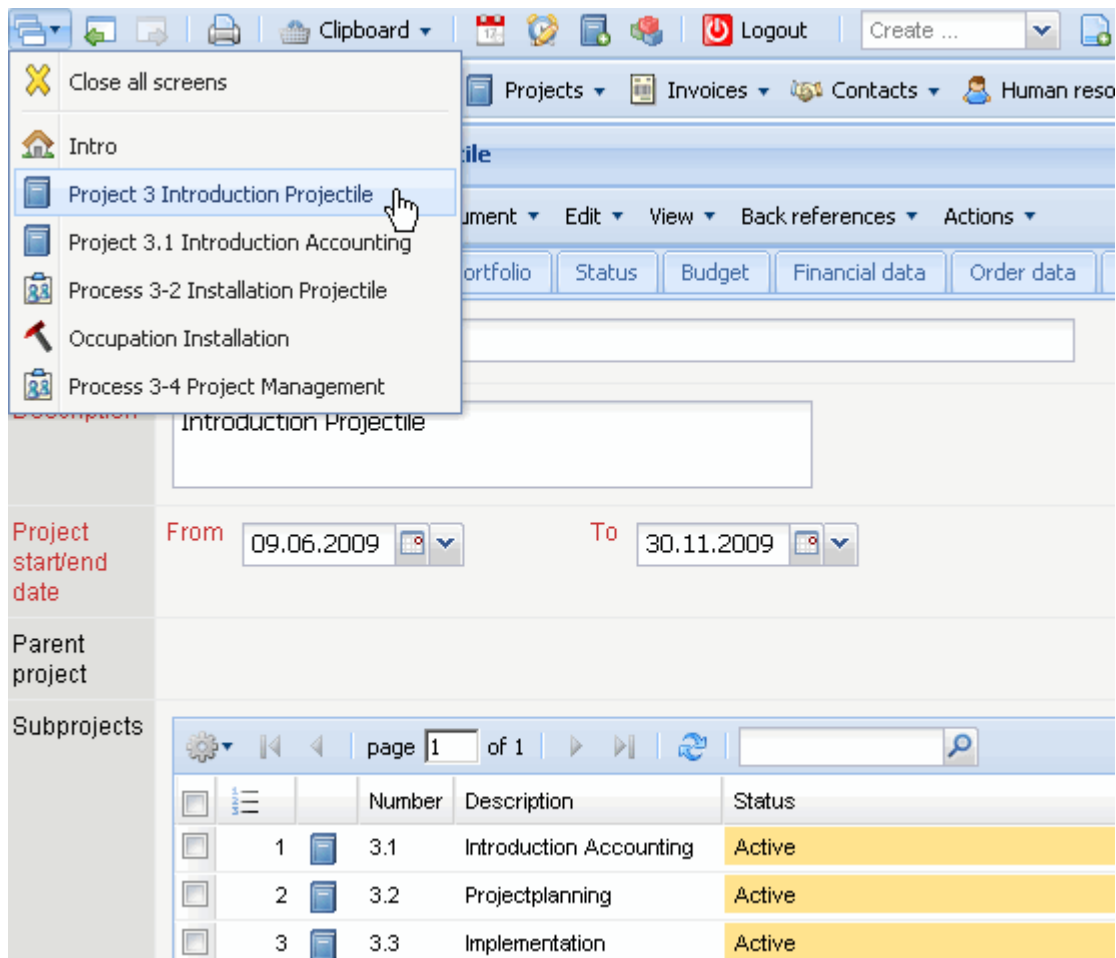
Using “ Close all screens” all opened screens ...
